

Environmental Policy

We have established this environmental policy to be consistent with the purpose and context of our organisation. It provides a framework for the setting and review of environmental objectives in addition to our commitment towards the following:

- Protect the environment, including the prevention of pollution
- To sustainable resource use, climate change mitigation, protection of biodiversity and ecosystems
- Conform to applicable legislative, regulatory and compliance obligations
- Continually improve our environmental management system and to enhance environmental performance by promoting sustainable development, in partnership with its stake holders by conserving energy, materials and resources through minimising consumption, maximising consumption, maximising efficiency and effectively managing waste.
- Work to prevent pollution through the implementation of robust operational controls and reducing the pollution risks associated with our activities.
- Introduce environmental supply chain management to encourage suppliers to adopt environmentally sound practises.

We have produced environmental objectives which relate to this policy and they can be found in document ER04 Environmental Objectives.

TCi recognises the importance of the environmental issues. Throughout its commercial activities and operations, it is committed to fostering the preservation and protection of the environment and promoting sustainable development.

The policy is implemented through the adoption of our ISO 14001, which is integrated throughout all sectors of the business.

The Directors of each business are responsible for providing a comprehensive infrastructure to support line management in discharging its environmental obligations. This shall include:

- Control of relevant documentation;
- Environmental supply chain management ;
- Inclusion of sustainability principles in any design, procurement and operational activities;
- Environmental performance monitoring through audit and review;
- Training;
- Dissemination of information, including legal requirements, procedure, statistics, reference material, relevant experience and audit recommendations;
- Environmental incident investigation;
- Reviewing this policy to ensure that environmental issues arising from new developments and changes to legislation are properly considered.

This policy is communicated to all interested parties as well as being made available to the wider community through publication on our Website, Company Noticeboard and Intranet.
