- Preventing pollution through the implementation of robust operational controls and reducing the pollution risks associated with the activities of the business.
- The introduction of environmental supply chain management to encourage suppliers to adopt environmentally sound practises.

TCi recognises the importance of environmental issues. Throughout its commercial activities and operations, it is committed to fostering the preservation and protection of the environment and promoting sustainable development.


This policy is implemented through the adoption of ISO 14001:2015 accreditation, which is integrated throughout all sectors of the business.

- Reviewing this policy to ensure that environmental issues arising from new developments and changes to legislation are properly considered.
